I am filled with gratitude as I reflect on the high holidays here at Temple Beth David. I witnessed the tremendous amount of effort by our community in making these sacred holy days a success...setting up chairs & tables, cooking & baking, practicing shofar, learning torah and haftarah portions, sound checks, passing out books, decorating, teaching our children about holidays, and much more. *Todah rabah* - thank you so much for your hard work and dedication!



My gratitude extends to every person who attended a service, in person or virtually. In whatever ways you participate and engage, your presence makes a difference. The amazing sounds of the holidays were inspiring: waking up spiritually by the shofar blasts, hearing Cantor Bill's beautiful voice throughout services, and listening to children sing Avinu Malkeinu with *ruach* - spirit.

We move away from the days of repentance, the day of atonement, to days of celebration. In blessings, Sukkot is referred to as *z'man simchateinu*, "the time of our celebrating." During Sukkot, we give thanks, particularly for food and shelter. Then, as a community, we celebrate endings and beginnings as we read the conclusion of one cycle of the Torah and the beginning of another.

During this time of renewal and gratitude, I am drawn to three connected Jewish values:
