

A message from the Rabbi

May 2023,

Dear Temple Beth David friends,

One of my favorite holidays is coming up at the end of this month and I am looking forward to sharing its customs and traditions with you.



The last week of May brings us to Shavuot (the feast of weeks). Our lead-up to this very important holiday is the process of counting each evening. For those who have been attending Shabbat services with me, whether in person or virtually, you have heard me talk about the traditions surrounding the counting of the omer and together we have been participating in this ancient custom. Each day of the Omer is acknowledged by number every evening after nightfall, from the second night of Passover till the night before Shavuot.

Counting each night is symbolically important. This process illustrates how we are taught to value every single day as being special all on its own. Each week of the counting, we focus on a different, specific Jewish value and how these values build upon one another to help us grow and deepen our own connection to living a holy life.

What does that mean to us? Living with a sense of holiness in how we approach life, in how we treat others, how we use our words and our actions is one way that we stay connected to Adonai and to one another. Holiness is a way to internalize and maintain our integrity.

What are we counting toward? We are counting the days leading to the receiving of Torah at Mt Sinai. It is said that every Jewish soul stood at Sinai, born and not yet born, to witness the giving of the Torah. Our narrative teaches that The Divine offered us the Torah and that we each have to choose for ourselves to receive it.

The Kotzker Rebbe was once asked: "Why is Shavuot called Z'man Matan Torah (the time that the Torah was Given,' rather than 'the time the Torah was Received)?" He answered: "The giving took place on one day, but the receiving takes place at all times."

I look forward to "meeting you at Sinai" on Shavuot so that together, we may explore our own Jewish journeys, continue to build and reinforce our own sense of holiness, and choose, again and again, to receive Torah.

Ken was focusing on getting the cameras, the camera controller unit, the video mixer, and the computer to work as a system. In the pictures above, you can see the system spread out on a table, to verify that everything is working, as well as a hard-working 2nd vice President. Kathy Avalares is now, under the supervision of Larry Jasper, learning to run the new Yad system.
