<u>A message from the Rabbí</u>

Dear Friends and the Family of Beth David,

With deep sadness I am writing this message, especially for those of you who haven't yet heard about my sudden and unfortunate development. I happen to have cancer in my liver.

During my visit at home in Oregon during Pesach, I felt some discomfort in my abdomen that was too suspicious to ignore. Following through the recommendations of our dear friend,



who happens to be an oncologist, I conducted a series of tests upon my return to Florida at MOFFITT. The conclusion of the experts at MOFFIT was that I have a malignant tumor in my liver. Thanks God, no other metastases were found at this time.

Oncologists on both sides of the country started evaluating and offering ways forward. While MOFFITT experts offered only a palliative type of treatment, our friend at home with her own network of multidisciplinary experts, came with a curative approach. Obviously, together with Connie, we chose the curative path. It will involve a few months of systemic followed by a surgery that will remove the tumor and its surroundings out of the body.

I will be heading back home at the first of June to start my journey towards complete healing. Connie and I know that it is going to be a herculean endeavor, which will impact many facets of our lives, the economic aspect could be one of them. As we, the Board, the relevant committees, and I are grappling with the best response to the change imposed on us, having the best interest of Beth David family and friends in our minds, I offered to continue supporting you from afar as much as I can for as long as you will need. Classes will continue on Zoom and I will make myself available to answer your individual questions and needs that can be address in telecommunications.

I intend to publish words of Torah and lessons on Israel and Jewish Thought in my website, at <u>www.rabbiemanuel.faith</u>. I invite you to visit, ask questions and write me your comments about what you learned.

I have deep faith and complete trust in HaShem who will guide the caring team and all those who are supporting me on the path that leads to a complete and full healing.

I want to thank you from the depth of my heart for the opportunity you gave me to serve as your spiritual leader and for your acceptance and trust in me. I do hope that I succeeded, even to a small extent, to fulfill some of the expectations you had of me.

My deepest gratitude goes to all of you for your blessings and prayers for my healing. I truly believe that these are important components in the remedies that will eventually cure me.






